

## DATA PROTECTION

The safety of your personal data when visiting our website is of great importance to us.

We assure you that we will not ask you for any personal data or electronically store any personal data from you.

### 1. Gathering and processing data

You can visit our website without having to provide any information about yourself. We store only access data, without any personal reference, such as the browser type and version, the operating system used, the referrer URL (the site visited previously), the host name of the visiting computer (IP address) and the time of the server's access request. These data are then used solely to improve our offering and do not enable us to draw any conclusions about your person.

### 2. Cookies

We do not use cookies on our website.

### 3. Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a Web analysis service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies" – text files that are stored on your computer that enable your use of the website to be analysed. The information that the cookie generates about your usage of this website (including your IP address) is sent to a Google server in the USA, where it is stored. Google uses this information to evaluate your use of the website, to compile reports about website activity for the website owners and to offer more services related to the use of the website and the Internet. Google may also pass this information on to third parties, if this is required by law, or to the extent that third parties process the data on behalf of Google. Google will under no circumstances connect your IP address with other Google data. You can prevent cookies from being stored on your computer by adjusting the settings of your browser software accordingly. We point out, however, that this may mean that you cannot utilise all the functions of this website to their fullest extent. By using this website you declare your consent to Google processing the data collected relating to you in the way and for the purposes described above.

Whenever you visit our website, your browser opens a direct connection to the Facebook Inc. servers, through which the content of the Facebook plugin on the Facebook Inc. servers is made available and directly integrated into our website via your browser.

If you are a Facebook member and are logged into Facebook while visiting our website, your visit can be associated with your Facebook user account. If you click on the »Like« button, this information is also transmitted directly to Facebook and saved there. You can prevent your visit to our website from being associated with your Facebook account by logging off Facebook beforehand.
